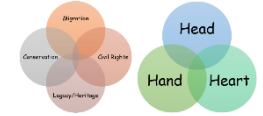





<p><b>Emmeline Pankhurst</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Wanted women to be able to vote, just like men.</li> <li>• Gave speeches and led protests.</li> <li>• Thanks to her, women in the UK can now vote.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Mahatma Gandhi</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Wanted his country to be free from British rule.</li> <li>• Taught people peaceful ways to protest.</li> <li>• Inspired people to stand up for what's right.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Rosa Parks</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• People were being treated unfairly because of their skin colour.</li> <li>• Refused to give up her bus seat to a white person.</li> <li>• Part of a significant event in the Civil Rights Movement.</li> </ul>	<p><b>David Attenborough</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Produces wildlife documentaries.</li> <li>• Raised awareness about issues with the environment.</li> <li>• Does conservation work to look after the environment.</li> </ul>
