Significant People			
<p>Julius Caesar</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Was a Roman General. Julius Caesar led two invasions of Britain in 55 and 54 BCE. The invasions failed. 			
<p>Emperor Claudius</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ordered the invasion of Britain in 43 CE. The invasion succeeded. Gained loyalty from tribes through treaties. 			
<p>Boudicca</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Queen of the Iceni tribe. Rebelled against the Romans. Her rebellion led to the destruction of towns like Londinium (London).
